Thought for the Week

Twenty Questions

"So you will know them by their fruit" – Matthew 7:20

Several friends laughed the night away as they enjoyed playing with a tiny electronic "Twenty Questions" game. The group would think of a common noun, such as a piano, mop, eyelash, or spoon, and then the gadget would begin asking questions: "Animal, mineral or vegetable?" "Is it lighter than a duck?" "Smaller than a microwave?" "Can you hold it?" "Can you put it in an envelope?" "Would you find it at a school?"

Amazingly, the game could figure out what they were thinking of in almost every instance by asking fewer than twenty questions – simply by finding out characteristics of the object.

People are similar to this tiny computer. They don't have to be told who is a Christian. Every action answers their every curiosity: how people spend their time and money and set their priorities, how much they help the needy, whether they are patient when wronged, how generous they are, how they treat children, whether they gossip, how they show or fail to show love for people. Every action bears fruit, revealing whether individuals are true disciples of Jesus Christ. "A good tree cannot have bad fruit. A bad tree cannot have good fruit" (Matthew 7:18). The lives we lead shout whether Christ is front and centre in our lives.

Lord, may my every action bear witness of Your Holy Spirit's work, leading people to a direct knowledge of the truth. Amen.
